

Threatens Legal Action Over Unflattering Photo

This supermodel is fighting mad over an unattractive photo that has been circulating online. Cindy Crawford is threatening legal action

against anyone who distributes or prints a doctored photo of her that was reportedly stolen from photographer John Russo, who shot her for the December 2013 issue of *Marie Claire Mexico and Latin America*. While Cindy, 49, and Russo insist that the pic was photoshopped to give the model a flabby tummy, it was being circulated as an “unretouched” shot, which could adversely affect her future career. “Based on this youth-obsessed culture, models have to look a certain way, and this [photo] makes Cindy look worse than she actually is,” NYC-based cosmetic dermatologist Dr. Paul Jarrod Frank tells *Closer*. “For better or worse, a model’s existence is based on the way she looks. It’s a lot of pressure.”
