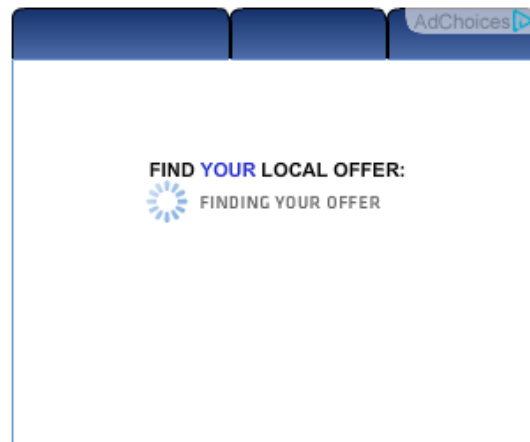




**T**ired of always looking tired? Have you tried every concealer and makeup trick in the book but can't seem to erase those under eye circles? It might be time to take things to the next level.

### **WATCH: Freeze Your Fat Off**

According to New York City-based plastic surgeon Paul Jarrod Frank, M.D., of the **Fifth Ave Dermatology Surgery & Laser Center**, under eye circles are caused by several genetic and environmental factors. Some of us are even more susceptible to the unsightly rings, particularly those of us with deeper set eyes.



By using a filler called Belotero, Dr. Frank shows us how doctors can reduce the appearance of the circles by filling the hollows and thickening the skin. The procedure, which costs between \$600 and \$1200, is quick and most patients can carry on with their normal activities immediately following treatment.
